Motion by Lang and Second by Meadows to approve the Consent Calendar. **Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.**

Motion by Lang and Second by Dailey to approve funding to Arts Los Altos, in the amount of \$45,000. **Motion failed due to a tie vote, with Councilmember Dailey and Vice Mayor Lang voting in favor; Councilmember Weinberg and Mayor Meadows opposed.**

Motion by Lang and Second by Meadows to approve funding to CASSY, in the amount of \$10,000. **Motion failed by roll call vote, with Councilmember Lang in favor, and Councilmember Dailey, Councilmember Weinberg, and Mayor Meadows opposed.**

Motion by Lang and Second by Dailey to approve funding for Compassion Week, in the amount of \$5,500. **Motion failed due to a tie vote, with Councilmember Dailey and Vice Mayor Lang voting in favor; Councilmember Weinberg and Mayor Meadows opposed.**

Motion by Lang and Second by Meadows to approve funding for the Los Altos Mountain View Community Foundation Summit, in the amount of \$10,000. **Motion carried 3-1 by roll call vote, with Councilmember Weinberg opposed.**

The City Council did not make a motion to approve funding for Live Oak Adult Day Services.

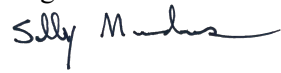
The City Council did not make a motion to approve funding for Loved Twice.
