SUBJECT: Selection of 2026/27 Community Center Gallery Themes

RECOMMENDATION:

Discuss and select the two 2026/27 themes for the Community Center Art Gallery call for art

BACKGROUND

The PARC Commission hosts an art display in the Los Altos Community Center Art Gallery. The Commission selects a theme for Recreation staff to include in each call for art.

Staff is ready to post the next call for art (Summer/Fall), and the Commission is charged with selecting the theme. Staff would like to request that the themes following Summer/Fall are discussed and decided so staff can schedule at their appropriate time. Commission discussion should include outreach parameters (Local, regional, beyond) as well as target artists or style. Previous selected themes should be taken into consideration.

Once staff has the information for displays, the Commission will be provided updates on when the selection process and art hanging will take place.
