Motion by Dailey and Second by Lang to approve the Consent Calendar. **Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.**

2. **Adoption of Resolution - Accept COPS Grant Funding**
Accept grant funding from the Citizens Option for Public Safety/Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (COPS/SLESF) and authorize revenue and allocate it to the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund for Fiscal Year 2025–26
3. **Adopt a Resolution - Approval of Memorandum of Understanding**
Adopt a Resolution to approve a successor Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Los Altos and Los Altos Municipal Employee Association

4. **Adoption of Resolutions - 999 Fremont Avenue**

- Adopt a resolution to transfer funding allocation from the Almond Fire Station Reroofing Project and the Fire Station Improvement Project and provide an additional \$118,008 to fully fund the project; and
- Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Ron Paris Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$657,069.99 and 20% contingency, if needed, in the amount not to exceed \$130,00.00. The total project cost will be \$787,070.00, and the Council's action is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA guidelines Section 15301(a), and that is one of the circumstances in the CEQA Guidelines

5. **Adoption of Resolution - Contract Extension with Flock Safety**

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract extension with Flock Safety in the amount of \$160,000 to extend the current contracts for an additional two years for maintenance and service for the 25 Flock Safety cameras in the City of Los Altos

Motion by Lang to direct staff to negotiate renewing the contract to align the two Flock contracts, with termination for convenience with reasonable notice. **Motion withdrawn.**

Motion by Weinberg and Second by Lang to direct staff to negotiate renewing the contract with conditions to terminate either contract for convenience on 30 days' notice; that the two current contracts be brought into alignment, either by folding the second contract into the first, or by changing the terms of the first contract; and that if Flock does not agree to these conditions, then the City will give notice of termination of the contract no later than 30 days before it expires.

Motion carried 3-1 by roll call vote, with Councilmember Dailey opposed.
